Will you pardon me in ask g yr kind favor, to do a little service for me wh is to send for F A Scratchley when you receive this as he leaves Lexgtn in a few days &ask him in my name as a request from me, to give you the box, with Mr Ns watch &chain& kev, wh he has been wear's—also Rev Dr F. E. Lawrences book of sermons I loan'd him &had my name in it_all of wh Genlyou will please keep for me until an opportune moment for you to send all to me.—When I took F A Sly Nov 1st/79 (from wh time I have done everything for him until Dec 21st/81 when he left me with ample means &wrote to me for more money &put his Bro Geo on me) he had no watch. I told him he c'ld wear Mr N, s also gave him the bill &certificate with it, in case anything happened while it was in his possession, to prove the watch & chain by—, but those he writes me he never had. My Southern heart & Sympathy made me give Mrs M M Scratchley (as she & her family were entire strangers to me) a 'Scholarship' to (then) "Washgtn College" for the education of her Sons, all of wh you know. I am paind to write you the duplicity &in gratitude of Mrs M.M. Sly &her Sons to me, to observe self-respect &christian endurance, forbids my having any further intercourse. —I do hope no one in Va or elsewhere, will ever be treated, or suffer by Mrs Sley & herfamily, Genlas I have.— But to be comforted, I must rem, ber the words of Peter "if ye suffer at all—it is better to suffer for well doing than for evil doing." —
